Working Professional MBA program

Earn your MBA from Anywhere, Part-time

Fisher's top ranked Working Professional MBA program delivers an educational experience shaped for you — and by you. Learn to think critically, cross-functionally, conceptually, and apply that knowledge to make decisions. Working with your academic advisor, you'll align the degree with unique passions, develop principled leadership and close skill gaps on a schedule that makes it possible without leaving your job behind.



Start autumn or spring semester (autumn shown above)

Flexibility: On-campus, Online or Both!

Create a schedule of weeknight or weekend classes. Control the workload of your MBA experience by taking anywhere from 1.5 to 9 credit hours in our autumn, spring or summer terms. Complete the program in as little as two years or as many as six. The average time to graduation is ~2.5 years (8 semesters) at 6 credit hours per semester.

Students can expect that courses are a synchronous and asynchronous mix, supported by video modules and recorded class sessions. Self-paced, asynchronous content is accessible 24/7, providing greater flexibility.

- 3 Register for the GMAT or GRE ¹**
Register and study for your preferred standardized test, or request a waiver to skip this requirement if approved. Applicants can request a waiver in our online application.
- 4 Register for the TOEFL or IELTS (if applicable)**
English requirement for international applicants
- 5 Connect with Fisher**
We encourage students to visit campus during an information session or MBA event. Fisher also provides webinars for those who cannot make it to campus.
